## Lavandula angustifolia 'Munstead'

- <u>Use:</u> Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun—part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY! Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 6-11, Tender perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- Create an English Foliage: Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
  - <u>Flower:</u> Fragrant purple spikes of blossoms in summer. Used for relaxing scent!
