

Goldfinch Shasta Daisy

Leucanthemum x superbum 'Goldfinch'

- **Use:** This is the yellowest flowering Shasta daisy ever! Long blooming and compact with semi-double flowers. 'Goldfinch' is the product of years of breeding for yellow flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 19" tall in bloom. Spreads to 24" in width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Charming semi-double flowers, very slowly and gracefully change from bright lemon yellow to an ivory white.
