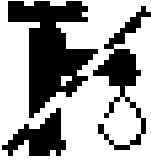


Sweet Christine Shasta Daisy



Leucanthemum × superbum Sweet Daisy 'Christine'

- **Use:** The Sweet Daisy series boasts a compact and tidy habit with flowers in abundance. Lets loose a florific profusion of dense, radiant blooms with spoon-shaped white petals arrayed around large golden button eyes. Strong-stemmed, well-branched plants provide extended flowering period starting in late spring. Mingles nicely with perennials or annuals in a mixed container. Great for the front of the border or in containers on the patio.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 8-10" tall in bloom. Spreads to 8-12" in width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Has unusual fluted or spoon shaped flower petals with bright yellow centers. Removing faded flowers will greatly increase the blooming time.

Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!
