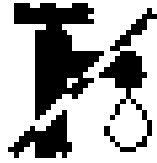


Sweet Diasy Jane Shasta Daisy



Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!



Leucanthemum × superbum 'Sweet Daisy Jane'

- **Use:** Strong-stemmed, well-branched plants provide extended flowering period starting in late spring. Mingles nicely with perennials or annuals in a mixed container.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 10-14" tall in bloom. Spreads to 8-12" in width.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green leaves.
- **Flower:** This selection from the Sweet Daisy series Golden yellow cone surrounded by bright white petals. Sturdy stems make it great as a cutflower. Heavy bloomer. Removing faded flowers will greatly increase the blooming time.
