

# White Mountain Shasta Daisy



## *Leucanthemum x superbum* 'White Mountain'

- **Use:** the cheerful workhorse of the garden! Bred to have more blooms over a longer period of time, this charming perennial extends the season by months. has a compact, tidy nature with the largest flowers of any shasta daisy - each blossom reaches up to 4-inches across! Lovely white flowers emerge on sturdy stems that will never need to be staked. There's no better choice for adding three seasons of color to your landscape!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 10-24" tall in bloom. Spreads to 12-24" in width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-10 ;Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Green leaves
- **Flower:** Produces radiant white flowers with bright yellow eyes that stand out against rich green foliage in a show lasting from spring to fall.

Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!
