Drought tolerant and long flowering!

Lewisia 'Little Plum'

- **Use:** An enchanting perennial with dainty, daisy-like blooms held in airy clusters and succulent evergreen foliage. Requires excellent drainage and dry soil after flowering. Just the right plant tucked into rock gardens, borders or used as edging.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part sun. Requires sharp drainage. If water is able to sit in the crown, it will cause the plant to rot. NO RED CLAY!
- **Growth:** Grows 6" high and 10-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Fleshy, flat rosettes of evergreen leaves.
- **Flower:** Many pink purple flowers that are tinted orange when they first open show above short, leathery dark green foliage. Blooming in spring and on and off until frost, it is perfect for the front of a border or walkway.
