

# Stargazer Lily



**Great for cut flowers  
and very fragrant!**

## *Lilium orientalis* 'Stargazer'

- **Use:** When Leslie Woodriff, a Lily breeder in California, created 'Star Gazer' a quarter of a century ago, it instantly set a new standard for Oriental Lilies. This fragrant hybrid grew beautifully in the average garden, and its large, upfacing blooms on strong stems were outstanding as cut flowers. If you have ordered flowers from a florist's shop lately, you know it's still one of the best-selling Lilies (and fetches \$6 per stem in our part of the country).
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Stems are less than 3ft tall, so they need no support.
- **Hardiness:** 5-11 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** This fabulous Lily has brilliant crimson flowers that are edged pure white and have a delightful fragrance.
