Deer resistant, bunny resistant, drought tolerant and attracts butterflies.

Lobelia cardinalis

- **Use:** Focal point plant in arresting red. This very dependable and vigorous selection will bloom even longer if you keep it dead headed. Lobelia loves moisture but will tolerate it drier in part shade. Normally Lobelia blooms from late June into October, some sources say this one blooms all summer. Hummingbird magnet! Cut flower. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established. This is a vigorous grower that performs best in moderately fertile, but well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly to 30" tall and plant them 12" apart.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. This hybrid has glossy, narrow foliage
- **Flower:** Tall spikes of stunning rose-pink and white flowers. Summer-fall flowers.
