A memorable sight for any garden lover, these beautiful plants grow into well-established clumps, with several stems rising up out of a single base. A bouquet of Lupines has no equal!



Lupinus polyphyllus 'Mini Gallery'

- **Use:** This new series of Lupine from HM Clause in France is touted as being more compact, more floriferous, and earlier blooming than the Gallery Series. In height, these are shorter than the popular Popsicle Series. **Exposure/Soil:** Best in full sun to light shade. Rich, organic soil. Prefer a little afternoon shade from scorching summers--mulch their roots to cool them down in summer. Cut back periodically.
- **Growth:** Reaches 14-16" tall and 7-9" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial; Will reseed.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Lobed leaves. Nitrogen fixing plant from the Legume family.
- **Flower:** 18" tall spires, densely loaded with pea-shaped flowers that open from bottom to top in shades of yellow, pink, red, and blue. Color marked on pot.
