

Golden Alexander Loosestrife



Lysimachia punctata 'Golden Alexander'

- **Use:** This easy-to-grow deciduous groundcover is a real gem. Excellent for covering large areas in part to full shade quickly.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun(would need a fair amount of regular watering) to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall and 24-36" wide. When grown in moist soil, *Lysimachia* tends to spread quite rapidly, so be sure to give it lots of room to grow. To reduce or eliminate spreading, plant this variety in drier soil in part shade, or grow it in a root barrier. These make wonderful, long lasting cut flowers for cheerful bouquets.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 Perennial Herbaceous.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lime green leaves edged in deep, creamy yellow.
- **Flower:** It produces the same starry yellow flowers as the species, clustered in the leaf axils from early to late summer.
