

White Mazus



Mazus reptans 'Alba'

- **Use:** Superb groundcover that forms a low creeping mat of green leaves, studded with small white flowers spring to summer. Perfect for use between flagstones or as a lawn substitute. Well suited for waterside plantings or in the woodland garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun in very moist areas, but prefers part sun.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly to 3" tall and plant them 15" apart. Roots as it creeps.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous, but mainly evergreen in mild winters. Good in-between stepping stones and rocks.
- **Flower:** Mini white orchid-like flowers have three fingered petals with one curving upwards. Blooms sporadically throughout the spring-fall season.
