Nepeta 'Blue Dreams'

- **Use:** A new clumping upright catmint from Japan! Pretty whorls of purple-blushed blue flowers, bigger than your average catmint by about 2x, with spotted lower lips on upright stems above fragrant green serrated leaves. Perfect for a garden border with butterflies & hummingbirds in mind & not too big.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Spanning 1.5' & reaching an only slightly taller 2' with blooms.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom keeps the plants' habit neat and will encourage some repeat bloom until frost.
