

Dwarf Catmint



Nepeta x faassenii 'Novanepjun' Plant Patent #23,074

- **Use:** A superb compact selection with finely textured, aromatic, gray-green foliage and soft, lavender flower spikes on a low, spreading habit. A sterile dwarf form of Walker's Low Catmint. Excellent for cascading off walls or container edges and as groundcover that tolerates periodic drought, when well-established. An herbaceous perennial. Nepetas prosper in ordinary (dare we say "poor") soil and heat, and host no pest that we know of.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 14 to 16 in. tall, spreading 30 to 36 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Blue-green foliage is fragrant.
- **Flower:** A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom keeps the plants' habit neat and will encourage some repeat bloom until frost.
