

# Limelight Catmint



Your cats will love it! Very easy to grow!

## ***Nepeta 'Limelight'***

- **Use:** Icy lime-green foliage showered with blue flowers all summer long. Extremely low habit makes this plant a natural choice for borders or along garden paths. Drought tolerant, deer resistant and butterflies and hummingbirds love it! It flowers profusely and long, especially if sheared. The blue-purple flowers are small but abundant, and the foliage is aromatic.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 1' tall and 2' wide. Not as vigorous as other catmints, but a tidy plant. A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom and will encourage repeat bloom until frost.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-8b Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Chartreuse foliage is aromatic.
- **Flower:** Topped by blue foliage favored by pollinators in spring to summer and beyond is trimmed.
