

# Catmint



## *Nepeta 'Walker's Low'*

- **Use:** Like others in this genus, 'Walker's Low' offers delicately hairy gray-green leaves with a tangy, fresh fragrance that a friend calls "spicy mint" and clouds of small purplish blue flowers carried on 8-9in spikes for several weeks in midsummer. Nepetas prosper in ordinary (dare we say "poor") soil and heat, and host no pest that we know of.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 30" tall and 36" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** A rough shearing (cut stems back by about 2/3) after bloom keeps the plants' habit neat and will encourage some repeat bloom until frost.
