

# Magenta Dwarf Sundrops



## *Oenothera kunthiana* 'Glowing Magenta'

- **Use:** A low-spreading perennial that produces showy, magenta, four-petaled flower cups throughout the summer and into autumn. The fragrant, satiny blooms are striking against the rich green, lance-shaped foliage. Once established, this tough and drought tolerant beauty puts on quite a show!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun. Fairly drought tolerant and needs little water once established, but prefers good drainage.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 6 to 12 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-10; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Rich green, lance-shaped foliage.
- **Flower:** . Produces deep magenta-pink four-petaled flowers throughout summer. Blooms open in morning and evening when temperatures are cooler.

Super easy to grow! An ideal plant for edging or groundcover, a rock garden accent, or for mixed border or containers.
