Oxalis triangularis 'Ebony Allure'

- **Use:** The newest and darkest oxalis available today. It has deep purple to inky black triangular- shaped leaves with bursts of pink flowers arriving in the spring and summer months. Oxalis triangularis sometimes has a brief dormancy in the dead of winter but in spring it will sprout quickly looking refreshed and lush. Enjoy these fast growers as houseplants, perennials or tucked into a rock garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers light shade and moist but well-drained soil outdoors. Indoors, provide bright light and cool temperatures.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-12" wide and high. Too much shade and they may get taller. Clumper, not spreader.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Perennial. Also can be a houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The handsome 3-lobed foliage is jet-black with large, shamrock-shaped leaves.
- **Flower:** .The clumps are topped in spring-fall with light pink flowers that fade into white.
