

Green Carpet Japanese spurge



Pachysandra terminalis 'Green Carpet'

- **Use:** A maintenance-free ground cover is one of the most popular ground covers. It is an excellent ground cover for shady and problem areas as it grows in any soil and is one of the few ground covers that will grow under pine trees. Pachysandra will transform your otherwise bare and ugly ground areas into attractive year-round cover.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** In comparison to the species, 'Green Carpet' is a more compact form (grows to 6-8" tall) Plants will spread by rhizomes to form large colonies. Plant 1-1.5' apart.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen stems that hold extra glossy, bright green leaves. Virtually problem free. which produces darker green leaves with shinier surfaces than straight species.
- **Flower:** Tiny white flowers in 1-2" long terminal spikes bloom in early spring.
