

'Champagne Bubbles' Iceland Poppies



Papaver nudicale 'Champagne Bubbles'

- **Use:** This is a naturalizing annual. Which means they will bloom, set seeds, they'll germinate, and every fall and each spring you will have gorgeous poppies in your garden! Long-lasting and with strong stems, they are splendid in the border but are also excellent in containers. Icelandic poppies have a longer bloom period than the Orientals. Good for cutting if stems are picked just as the buds begin to open. Removing faded flowers will encourage more buds to form. Allow plants to set seed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun and sandy soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 30" tall x 12" wide and continues to spread by seed.
- **Hardiness:** 2-9, Perennial. Save some seeds and spread them where you please.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lobed leaves. Goes dormant in summer heat.
- **Flower:** This is a superb variety with enormous blossoms in bright and enticing shades of orange, pink, scarlet, apricot, yellow and creamy-white.

**Poppies like the cool weather! They will bloom in the fall and the biggest show is in early spring!
