

# Cha Cha Cherry Bearded Tounge/ Penstemon



## ***Penstemon 'Cha Cha Cherry'***

- **Use:** The vibrant, dark cherry-red flowers of this easy perennial are sure to be the brightest spot in the garden and a magnet for hummingbirds and butterflies. Dark green leaves cloak its upright, bushy form, with blooms starting in late spring to early summer, continuing into fall in many climates. Perfect for borders and mixed containers, and a cutting garden essential!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Reaches 22 to 24 in. tall and wide; bloom stalks to 28 inches.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thin, dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Dark cherry-red flowers and a upright, bushy habit. It is very free-flowering and blooms from spring to late fall. The lovely dark seed heads are great for arrangements.

Lovely as a cut flower and long blooming too.
