Penstemon 'Red Rocks'

- <u>Use</u>: This lovely hybrid is a 1999 Plant Select® winner. Developed by Bruce Meters, "Red Rocks"™ is named after Denver's famous amphitheater which was carved out of the spectacular red sandstone cliffs in the foothills west of the city.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
 Drought tolerant once established. This is a vigorous grower that performs best in moderately fertile, but well-drained soils.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows quickly to 18" tall and plant them 15-20" apart.
- Hardiness: 5-10 Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous.
- **Flower:** This hybrid has glossy, narrow foliage and tall spikes of stunning rose-pink and white flowers. Summer-fall flowers.
