

# Forever Pink Phlox



**Blooms attract butterflies and are delightfully fragrant. Deer resistant.**



## ***Phlox 'Forever Pink' PP 24,918***

- **Use:** A remarkable early bloomer that produces flowers with wide, overlapping petals in early June, then blooms intermittently all summer long and into fall. The flowers never set seed, which accounts for their unusually long bloom time. A very impressive introduction from Dr. Jim Ault at the Chicago Botanic Garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial shade is best. Prefers moist, well drained soil, but is fairly drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 16" tall and 15-18" wide. Plants will spread and can form large colonies over time.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Light green, mildew-resistant foliage grows on upright stems, forming compact clumps that don't require staking.
- **Flowers:** Shines with cheery, purple-pink blooms that cover plants in June. Plants re-bloom throughout summer and into fall, earning the name 'Forever Pink'.
