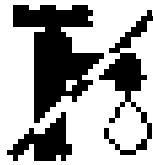


# Blue Moon Woodland Phlox



## *Phlox divaricata* 'Blue Moon'

- **Use:** Selected for outstanding flower color and very full flower petals, 'Blue Moon' bears many fragrant, 5-petaled flowers with the arrival of spring. Enjoy a knee-high sea of elegant, violet-blue flowers while simultaneously attracting hummingbirds & butterflies into your garden. A long-lived, carefree native groundcover
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial shade is best. Prefers moist, well drained soil, but is fairly drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15 tall and wide. Plants will spread and can form large colonies over time.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10; Will need protection from cold winds in our area.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Foliage is lance shaped and medium green.
- **Flowers:** Fragrant blue blooms on compact plants.
