

Bright Eyes Garden Phlox



Phlox paniculata 'Bright Eyes'

- **Use:** An old-timer but still one of the best. The blooms are a pale pink with a crimson eye that winks at you from 3ft stems. It's rare to find a design that can't be improved by the addition of these glorious plants. Grow some in the cutting garden, for if cut with half of the flowers open, they will fill your home with their perfume.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Does not like sprinklers, water soil not leaves.
- **Growth:** Fast growth of 36"h x 18-24" wide
- **Hardiness:** 4-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Light green mildew resistant foliage.
- **Flower:** Fragrant, tubular flowers (1/2" to 1" diameter) with long corolla tubes and five flat petal-like lobes are soft pink with red eyes. Individual flowers are densely arranged in large, terminal, pyramidal clusters (panicles to 6-9" long) atop stiff, upright stems which seldom need staking. Long mid to late summer bloom sometimes extends into early fall.
