

Pop Star Pink Balloon Flower



Gorgeous pink balloon flowers and deer resistant!

Platycodon grandiflorus 'Astra Pink'

- **Use:** Balloon Flowers are summer-blooming cousins to the more familiar Bellflowers. This forms an upright mound of green foliage, bearing inflated buds that pop open into star-shaped soft-pink blossoms. Nice addition to the border, or in mixed containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-10” tall and 6-8” wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen if brought indoors in winter
- **Flower:** This heavy bloomer has very large pink flowers that begin in the shape of a balloon before opening, hence it's name.
