

Danessa Mix Primrose



Primula acaulis 'Danessa Mix'

Primroses are rosette-forming herbaceous perennials with clusters of solitary flowers arising from the rosette in late winter or early spring



- **Use:** Danessa is a unique heat tolerant Primrose. Excellent plant habit and a good range of bright core colours, ideal for spring or after-Summer colour in the gardens. Beloved harbinger of spring that puts forth an abundance of cheery blossoms. Fragrant and can also be used as a houseplant and later planted in the garden to come back again next year! Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil. Keep water off the leaves and flowers for best results. Must have good drainage and prefer not to be watered from overhead. Beware of slugs and snails.
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and 8" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial; Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. May go summer dormant, but more heat tolerant than most primrose on the market.
- **Flower:** Large flowers 2-2.5 inches/5-6 cm across in full assortment of rich colors.
