

# Noverna Deep Blue Primrose



## *Primula capitata* 'Noverna Deep Blue'

- **Use:** Beloved harbinger of spring that puts forth an abundance of cheery blossoms. This cultivar is primine free and safe to touch. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil. Keep water off the leaves and flowers for best results. Beware of slugs and snails.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-10" tall and 6-8" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Tender Perennial; Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. May go summer dormant.
- **Flower:** It forms a low rosette of grey-green foliage. Drumstick style powdery-white stems rise taller, bearing clusters of deep blue Scabiosa-like flowers during late spring and early summer.

**A true spring plant with beautiful firm, bright green leaves and cheerful flowers.**
