Rudbeckia hirta 'Cherry Brandy'

- **Use:** A wonderful easy-care addition to a sunny bed or border. In optimum conditions, may naturalize in the garden by self-seeding. Looks amazing with grasses.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water once established. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 20 in. tall, 15 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Reseeds. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Slightly fuzzy leaves.
- **Flower:** Beautiful, cherry red petals surround a dark chocolate center on the world's first red flowered Rudbeckia! Blooms continuously, throughout summer; will bloom more profusely with regular deadheading.
