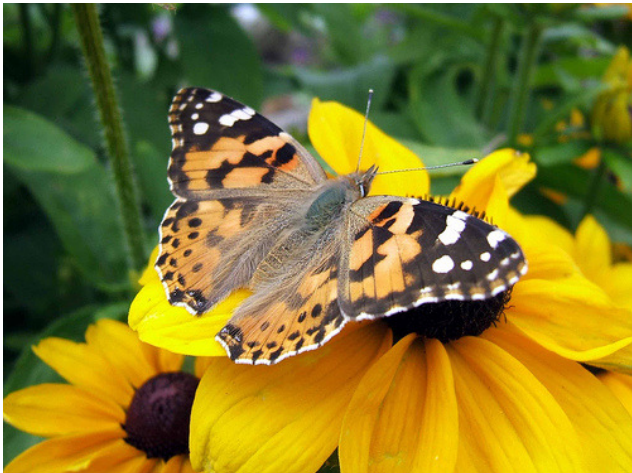


# Toto Lemon Black eyed Susan



## *Rudbeckia hirta* 'Toto Lemon'

- **Use:** Looks great with any type of grass, in borders or mass plantings in sunny gardens. This compact, dwarf type will create a stunning display in the garden. Compact and very dwarf, early flowering with perfect, weather-resistant blooms that continue to shine for a very long time. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Gloriosa Daisy hybrids are short-lived perennials, sometimes treated as annuals. Often these will survive a few winters, or at least self seed. This compact strain produces large brown-eyed daisy flowers for months on end.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water once established.
- **Growth:** Grows to a height of 12-16in. and a spread of 15in.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10 Perennial. Reseeds. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Petals are a cheery bright lemon-yellow shade. An outstanding cut flower. Removing faded blossoms regularly will greatly increase the flowering time. Seed heads have good winter interest, and can be used in dried arrangements. Fairly drought tolerant, once established. Wonderful in mixed containers.
