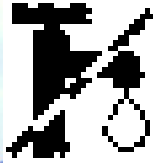


Salvia 'Amistad'



Puts a lantana to shame with all of its blooms, growth, and strength. Exciting NEW plant!



Salvia 'Amistad'

- **Use:** Dark purple flowers with nearly black calyx bloom constantly from early spring until frost. Amistad is more compact and has a fuller habit than other guaranitica types. Flowers are a magnet for butterflies and hummingbirds. Deer resistant too!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 3-4' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** 8-11 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful deep blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!
