## Blue Marvel Salvia













- <u>Use:</u> Deep blue spikes on a free flowering compact dwarf plant. Vigorous and broad enough for any size garden, especially useful if you need a blue in the foreground. Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts humming-birds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage. Drought tolerant once established
- Growth: Full, well branched plants grow 10-12" wide in one season.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Fragrant, green-silvery leaves.
- Flower: Flower spikes are covered with beautiful blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
