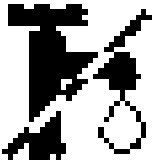


Salvia Indigo Spires



We love them for their long lasting beautiful blue blooms and strength. Drought tolerant and deer resistant.



Salvia 'Indigo Spires'

- **Use:** This notable bush-like Salvia produces stately spires of purple blossoms. The blue bracts and stem retain their color in dried flower arrangements. If grown in pots indoors in a sunny spot, the flowers continue through the winter.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 2-3' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** 7-8 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter. Also can be a houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful deep blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!
