

Furman's Red Gregg's Sage



Salvia greggii 'Furman's Red'

- **Use:** The small dark-green leaves adorn the stems that are topped from July until frost with short, spikes of brilliant red flowers...a real show stopper! Drought tolerant once established, and loves full, hot sun! Prefers well-drained soils.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 2-3' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 6-10; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful reddish pink flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!
