

# Wild Thing Gregg's Pink Sage



## *Salvia greggii* 'Wild Thing'

**We love them for their long lasting blooms and strength. In the heat and drought.**

- **Use:** The small dark-green leaves adorn the stems that are topped from July until frost with short, spikes of brilliant purple flowers...a real show stopper! Drought tolerant once established, and loves full, hot sun! Prefers well-drained soils. Deer resistant and attracts hummingbirds in droves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 2-3' tall and wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7-11 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Use 3-4" around plant in the winter. Plants will not come out of winter dormancy until late May the following year.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with bubblegum pink flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!
