- **Use:** A carefree perennial for waterwise gardens! Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies summer-long with vibrant color and aromatic foliage. Flowers produce a brilliant display against bright green foliage. Thrives in heat and drought when established. A fantastic selection for borders, mass plantings or large patio tubs.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 30 in. tall and 36 in wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 6-11 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Use 3-4" around plant in the winter. Plants will not come out of winter dormancy until late May the following year.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Its tiny, smooth, elliptical leaves form a light, airy backdrop for the dramatic flowers. Cutting grown. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with white flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October!
