

Salute Deep Blue Salvia



Salvia nemerosa 'Salute Deep Blue'

- **Use:** Drought tolerant, reliable once established, and generally pest and disease free, they combine an array of flowers and aromatic foliage in many different sizes, shapes, and hues. Fairly drought and humidity tolerant once established and deer resistant. Truly a garden sensation.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage in winter. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 12-18" tall and 12-15" wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 4-8**; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Well-branched and prolific blooming, these strong growers are valued for their tidy habit with lush spikes of violet opening to deep purple blue.



Looking for a summer show of intense color? Easy to grow, salvias perform best in full sun.
