

# Dark Blue Meadow Cleary Sage



Fall in love with Salvias! They are easy and a must have in the garden! Drought tolerant, deer resistant, and lovely for a blue garden.

## *Salvia pratensis* 'Ballet Twilight Serenade'

- **Use:** Known for its richly hued flower spikes above bright green textured foliage. Use as an edging plant in a white theme garden, attracts honey-bees. Dense flower heads, rich flowering. Mounds of foliage with upright flower spikes, very striking.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established,
- **Growth:** Reaches 18-24" in height and 16" width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8 ; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Strongly aromatic light green leaves.
- **Flower:** Deep violet-blue hooded flowers on upright stems are long blooming . Reblooms after dead heading, June- October. Great for cut flowers.
