

White Meadow Cleary Sage



***Salvia pratensis* 'Swan Lake Ballet'**

- **Use:** Use as an edging plant in a white theme garden, attracts honey-bees. Dense flower heads, rich flowering. Mounds of foliage with upright flower spikes, very striking.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established,
- **Growth:** Reaches 18-24" in height and width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8 ; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Strongly aromatic light green leaves.
- **Flower:** Straight white plumes of flowers. Reblooms after dead heading, June- October. Great for cut flowers.
