

Pink Mist Pincushion Flower



Scabiosa japonica 'Pink Mist'

- **Use:** The sister to "Butterfly Blue", it retains all the great attributes of a Scabiosa, but with soft pastel pink flowers. One of the longest flowering perennials. Multiple pincushion shaped flowers produced all season. Very compact with ferny blue-grey foliage. A garden favorite. Tidy plants are valued for mass bedding effects or mixed perennial borders. Perfect for container gardens. Attracts butterflies!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers morning sun and afternoon shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Appreciates slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Grows on 12-15" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-8; perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous
- **Flowers:** Wonderful large pink flowers from June to October. Perpetual flowering if old flower heads are removed. Spring-Fall.

One of the most beautiful garden perennials.
