

Terra Sedum / Ice Plant Planter



Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Perfect for edging a driveway where the temperatures can top 100F. Comes back every year with little maintenance!

- **Use:** These hardy planters will survive the toughest of conditions. Thrives on neglect and easily adapts to soils ranging from pure sand to solid clay, but of course prefers sandy soils. Attractive used as a ground cover or planted in a rock wall and drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun. Needs very little water. If plants become too big simply pinch off and replant in another pot.
- **Growth:** Grows to 8" tall and can spread to form a colorful low-growing matt to 20" across.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous/Semi-evergreen. Various leaves
- **Flower:** Flowers vary per type in the pots. Most blooming mid-late summer.
