

Coppertone Stonecrop



Sedum nussbaumerianum

- **Use:** Orange and green foliage turns bright coppery red in sun. Trailing habit, great for hanging baskets. Drought and heat tolerant. White fragrant star-shaped blooms.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 4" tall and continues to spread. Plants may be pruned back at any time if they get too large.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual Hardy to 25 degrees. Bring indoors in winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cylindrical foliage that turns a magnificent coppertone color in the sun.
- **Flower:** Clusters of white starry flowers appear during the summer.

Great for containers in hot locations with extreme heat.
