## *Sedum spathulifolium* 'Carnea'

- **Use:** Rock gardens, borders, edging, under shady trees and steep banks will come alive with carefree color of this creeping Sedum. They fill troublesome areas with neat 3-4" tall cover. Spreads fast. Does not need pruning. Tolerant of dry infertile soils and is useful for covering difficult places and providing erosion control on banks.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs to be planted in full sun in well-drained soil. It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 4" tall and spreads 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen foliage, Little rosettes of silvery blue, fleshy leaves with hints of red and purple.
- **Flower:** In summer yellow flowers hovering above the mat forming ground cover.
