

Tricolor Creeping Sedum



Sedum spurium 'Tricolor'

- **Use:** Rock gardens, borders, edging, under shady trees and steep banks will come alive with carefree color of this creeping Sedum. They fill troublesome areas with neat 3-4" tall cover. Spreads fast. Does not need pruning. Tolerant of dry infertile soils and is useful for covering difficult places and providing erosion control on banks.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs to be planted in full sun in well-drained soil. It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 4" tall and spreads 18-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen foliage, Leaves (each to 1" long) feature green in the center with white margins tinged with pink. Leaves are opposite, thick, succulent, toothed near the tips, obovate, flattened and narrower than those of the species. Leaf color remains attractive throughout the growing season.
- **Flower:** Bright pink star like flowers cover the Creeping Red Sedum plant from June through September.
