***Sedum spurium* 'Voodoo'**

- **Use:** Rich, deep mahogany-red leaves and glowing rosy-red flowers provide bold, contrasting color. Drought tolerant and easy care groundcover. A great choice for rock gardens, low borders, or as a container accent. Tolerant of dry infertile soils and is useful for covering difficult places and providing erosion control on banks.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs to be planted in full sun in well-drained soil. It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 4 to 6 in. tall, 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen foliage, even in sub-zero weather. Dark red foliage.
- **Flower:** Rose pink summer flowers.
