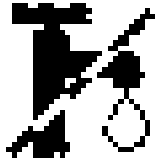


# Turkish Delight Stonecrop



## *Sedum ussuriense* 'Turkish Delight'

- **Use:** Stonecrop are easy to grow and withstand poor, dry soil conditions so are often a good choice for xeriscaping. This dwarf selection is taller than alpine types and shorter than border types. The succulent, rounded leaves are dark burgundy, almost black, with carmine-red flower clusters appearing late summer through fall. Perfect for rock gardens, containers, troughs and between flagstones. Although fairly shade tolerant, plants might not flower very well.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs to be planted in full sun in well-drained soil. It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12" tall and spreads 12-16" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark burgundy, almost black, succulent foliage
- **Flower:** Topped with large heads of carmine red flowers from August to November.
