Stachys byzantine 'Silver Carpet'

- **Use:** An improved selection over the original garden favorite with dense, silver-white, woolly foliage. Garden visitors will enjoy the soft feel of the foliage. An excellent low-maintenance, non-flowering option for edging a path, or as a low border planting. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 12 in. tall, gradually spreading to form a dense mat.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen; 4 inch long velvety, soft, lamb's ear-shaped leaves; light gray-green and covered with white hairs
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
