Stachys monieri 'Hummelo'

- **Use:** Painted in plush, deep fuchsia shades, droves of tightset, tubular flowers are lifted above a tidy, compact rosette on stout, straight stalks. This perky, nearly ever-green perennial should be granted a front-row seat where its long blooming act can easily be savored.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to just 20 inches tall, 12 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Crinkled and round-tipped medium green foliage that stays close to the ground.
- **Flower:** Deep purple stalks of flowers in the summer.
