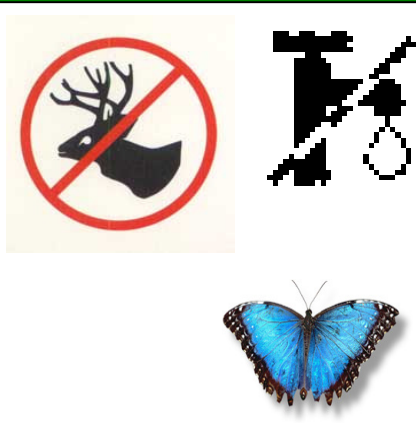


# Samuri Toad Lily



## *Tricyrtis formosana* 'Samurai'

- **Use:** This toad Lily is one of the few varieties of *Tricyrtis* with variegated leaves that is a good, tough garden plant with clean foliage! Green leaves with creamy, almost gold edges are topped in fall with lily-like flowers of purple with dark purple spotting with yellow throats. Best admired from close by, it is lovely planted near a patio or sitting area mixed with other shade perennials.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in part shade in well-drained soil rich in organic matter. Water well on planting and regularly until established. Cut back to refresh foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-18 tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-8, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; a spectacular golden-edged leaf form of the spreading *tricyrtis*.
- **Flower:** In early summer and sporadically into fall, the patches of 1' tall stalks are topped with 1" wide starfish-shaped flowers of white with heavy purple speckling.
