

White Empress Verbena



Verbena 'Empress Flair White'

This easy-to-grow plant makes an excellent ground cover in landscape beds, planted in masses or mingling with other plants such as euphorbia and petunias to add vibrant color.



- **Use:** Blooms in clusters of five lobed, bright white flowers. The dark green leaves are small and have serrated edges. Empress Flair has a trailing habit and looks great cascading over the side of baskets, patio pots or garden wall. The foliage stays dense to the ground making this plant great for the landscape also. If your plant gets leggy or slows in blooming, just trim the dead flower clusters or cut the plant back a bit. Butterflies and hummingbirds absolutely adore this plant as its slender stems carry clusters of colorful blooms all summer long.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Do not water center of the plant, try to water under the leaves. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-10" tall and continues to trail 1-2' a year wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual, May return when given a good mulching.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Green leaves have superior mildew resistance.
- **Flower:** Nonstop pure white fragrant flowers spring until fall. Self cleaning type.
