

Hot Pink Temari Verbena



Verbena 'Temari Hot Pink'

- **Use**: Good for trailing in a basket, on the ground, windowboxes, or in a container. Looks gorgeous planted up against variegated grasses in containers.
- **Exposure/Soil**: Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Do not water center of the plant, try to water under the leaves. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth**: Grows 8" tall and continues to trail 1-2'. Upright, but with a mounding habit.
- **Hardiness**: Zone 7b-10, Tender Perennial, will need mulch in the winter.
- **Foliage**: Deciduous; small lobed leaves
- **Flower**: Hot pink with a white eye it flowers all season



Blooms for 5 months and attracts butterflies.
